### Master of Arts in Communication Sciences and Disorders

#### Faculty/Staff

- 14 full-time faculty members
- 19 clinical educators with various areas of specialization

#### Master's Program

- 30-40 admitted every fall | 28% of applicants admitted
- Academic courses in: etiology, characteristics, diagnosis, and treatment of communication and swallowing disorders, across the lifespan
- 99% passing rate on Praxis on the 1<sup>st</sup> attempt
- 92% employed within 6 months post-graduation
